Dr Harriot Beazley is a human geographer and community development practitioner with a passion for rights-based research with children and young people in Southeast Asia (especially Indonesia). She is Program Coordinator (International Development) and Senior Lecturer (Human Geography) at the University of the Sunshine Coast, Australia. Harriot's PhD (ANU) research was focussed on the geographies and identities of street children in Indonesia. Since then has conducted research and published widely on the physical and emotional punishment of children in Vietnam and Cambodia (Save the Children), child labour and the commercial sexual exploitation of children in Indonesia (UNICEF), children's experiences in orphanages after the tsunami (Save the Children), and the impact of transnational migration on children in Lombok, Indonesia (SSHRC, Canada). She is Commissioning Editor (Pacific) for the Journal *Children's Geographies*.
