Dr. Catherine Allerton's current research explores children's experiences of parental migrations, illegality, potential statelessness, schooling exclusion and belonging in Sabah, Malaysia. Forthcoming open access articles on these themes include 'Impossible Children: illegality and Excluded Belonging among the Children of Migrants in Sabah, Malaysia' (*Journal of Ethnic and Migration Studies*) and 'Contested Statelessness in Sabah, Malaysia: Irregularity and the Politics of Recognition' (*Journal of Immigrant and Refugee Studies*). Her previous research was published as a book, *Potent Landscapes: Place and Mobility in Eastern Indonesia* (Hawai'i, 2013).
