Dr. Chand SOMAIAH is a Postdoctoral Fellow in the Asian Migration cluster at the Asia Research Institute, National University of Singapore. She received her PhD in Sociology from Macquarie University. Her research interests include mothering, gendered experiences of migration, Asian diasporas, multiple modernities, intimate citizenship practices, circulation of care, sociologies of the body and feminist methodologies. She is currently working collaboratively with an international research team on a mixed-method longitudinal study titled Child Health and Migrant Parents in Southeast Asia (CHAMPSEA): Wave 2. The project is investigating the longer-term impacts of parental absence on children from sending communities of international labour.

Professor Brenda S.A. YEOH is Professor (Provost's Chair) in the Department of Geography as well as Research Leader of the Asian Migration Cluster at the Asia Research Institute, NUS. Her research interests include the politics of space in colonial and postcolonial cities, and she has considerable experience working on a wide range of migration research in Asia, including key themes such as cosmopolitanism and highly skilled talent migration; gender, social reproduction and care migration; migration, national identity and citizenship issues; globalising universities and international student mobilities; and cultural politics, family dynamics and international marriage migrants. She has published widely in these fields.
